### Return Home Safe Program

Newport Police Department has developed the **Return Home Safe Program**. This program will assist in the safe and timely return of individuals who may wander and require police assistance to locate. Individuals at high risk for wandering include: children or adults with Autism, Alzheimer's disease, dementia, Down syndrome, and other developmental disabilities.

The **Return Home Safe Program** will consist of a registry of these at-risk individuals which will give officers quick and easy access to photos and pertinent information from their cruiser, therefore, assisting in locating your loved one if they should become lost or missing.

It is important to include key information on the **Return Home Safe Program** registration. Include individual's name, address, phone number, current photo, mode of communication, key phrases to help reduce trauma, emergency contact persons, and any other information to assist first responder in getting your loved one home safely.

Newport Police Department's most important responsibilities are serving and protecting our citizens. The police department can take a digital, head shot, photo or *you can bring in a photo of the registrant, but a clear, head shot, picture is required.*
