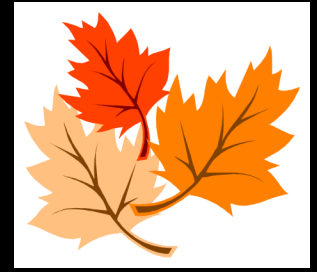


# Clean City Program's Fall Recycling Day

## RECYCLE

### Buy a pair of bins & recycle your old bin

Bring in old, broken recycling bins, and we will recycle them for you. You MUST bring proof of Newport residency and a check for payment. A limited number will be available at this reduced rate. Available on a first come, first served basis.

**\$5 for a pair of recycling bins!**

### Paper shredding

Paper shredding service (paper will be recycled): Four banker box size limit. Paperclips & staples ok. First come, first served.

### Styrofoam

Packaging, food trays, coffee cups and packing peanuts. Must be free of tape, labels and food particles. Must have "PS 6" symbol.

### Cooking oil

Vegetable oil recycled by Newport Biodiesel

### Electronics

TVs, computers/CPU's, misc parts & wires, monitors, mice, keyboards, fax machines, modems, routers, laptops, VCRs, DVD players, scanners, cell phones, air conditioners & more.

### Plastic bags

Plastic bags must be clean & dry. Please see Clean City Program website for a full list. Collected by the East Bay Met School.

### Rigid plastics

**NO FOOD CONTAINERS!** recycling bins, plastic toys, kiddie pools & sand boxes, buckets, lawn furniture, laundry baskets, plastic totes, milk crates, & more. Clean plastic only.

### Books

Book donations for Reading Tree: books, DVDs, VHS tapes. **NO** magazines, phonebooks, catalogs, moldy or mildew books
