Join the [Neighborhood Energy Challenge](http://www.NeighborhoodEnergyChallenge.org) (a community-wide project of Newport's Energy & Environment Commission)

Neighborhood Energy Challenge.org (NEC) is a non-profit volunteer group comprised of residents from Newport, Middletown, Portsmouth, and Jamestown, Rhode Island. Its mission is to encourage significant, measurable energy savings in these core communities, although all Rhode Islanders are welcome.

How it works –

- Log in at www.NeighborhoodEnergyChallenge.org and create your unique identity, then enter a few housing details, like whether you own or rent, and how many people are in your household
- Establish your starting point by entering information from your most recent energy bills in your “Carbon Snapshot”
- Start claiming energy-saving points on the Challenge “Tracker” - you can even claim points for things you've already done, and go back anytime to edit the information
- We'll send you reminders to update your score every month, and will include tips for even more ways to save during the next 12 months and beyond (e.g., discounts, tax credits, rebates and the like)
- Claiming Tracker points makes you eligible to win prizes and receive party invitations to celebrate everyone's energy saving achievements!

Join your neighbors in saving money on energy and reducing pollution and greenhouse gases. (If your neighbors haven't joined yet, why not encourage them to? You'll get points for it!)
